

## 2026 Enrolment Guidelines for International students Applying for Chinese language at China University of Petroleum (Beijing)

#### Introduction to China University of Petroleum, Beijing

## 1. Application Qualifications

- 1. Physically and mentally healthy, law-abiding, and non-criminal record, friendly towards China, able to meet the normal study and life at school.
- 2. Applicants should be a non-Chinese citizen who can study and live in the school in good health and with a sound mind. If both or one of the applicant's parents is a Chinese citizen and resides in a foreign country, the applicant has foreign nationality at birth. In that case, they do not have Chinese nationality and must have a record of actually living abroad for more than 2 years within the last 4 years. (Nine (9) months living abroad are equivalent to one year, subject to entry and exit visas).
  - Chinese emigrants who apply to come to China for undergraduate study as international students must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for more than 4 years. Within the 4 years, they must have a record of living abroad for more than 2 years (9 months abroad in a year can be calculated as one year, subject to entry and exit visas).
- **3.** High school graduate with high school diploma or above.

## 2. Required application materials

#### The following documents are required:

- 1. Passport information page
- 2. Visa pages (scanned copies of all China visa pages and entry-exit records)
- 3. Original highest education certificate, should be translated to Chinese or English if needed (If you have not graduated, please provide a "Pre-graduation certificate")
- 4. Original highest education transcript. (translated to Chinese or English)
- 5. Language proficiency certificate
- 6. Guardian authorization certificate (Only required by applicants under the age of 18)
- 7. Certificate of Non-criminal record
- 8. Physical examination form for foreigners
- 9. Accommodation registration certificate (Only for the applicants who are in China now)



- 10. Transfer certificate issued by the original school
- 11. Transcript issued by the original school
- 12. Certificate of creditworthiness

#### NOTE

- \*Freshmen abroad must provide materials:1-8,12; Freshmen within China must provide:1-9,12; and Transfer students within China need to provide:1-12.
- \*\*Certificate of creditworthiness: The funding requirement shall be calculated according to the annual basic expenses (tuition, accommodation, living expenses, insurance, etc.) of the program. The total amount of credit on creditworthiness certificate per program shall be more than 39000 RMB. It is required to deposit the corresponding amount in its own account for at least 1 month. In case another person's account is used, it is required to provide a certificate justifying the relationship between the applicant and the account owner. At the same time, the certificate should be notarized by local authorities and verified by a Chinese embassy or consulate abroad.
- \*\*Translated application materials need to be notarized before submission.

## 3. Specific Requirements:

#### **Training requirements:**

- 1.Adapted to all the four Chinese language abilities used in Chinese teaching environment, including listening, speaking, reading and writing skills
- 2. Master some basic professional knowledge
- 3. Gradually adapt to the teaching methods and learning methods of the university
- 4. Have the ability to learn and think independently.

#### **Program categories**

Chinese Class (long term): The long-term class (more than half a year) enrolls students twice a year, starting in March and September respectively, with different levels: primary, intermediate and advanced courses. The core courses include: reading and writing, listening and speaking, reading, intensive reading, scientific Chinese, and Chinese culture, etc.

According to the applicants' application and class placement interview results, several small classes will be organized for teaching. Each class will have listening, speaking, reading and writing courses to comprehensively develop students' four skills. Classes will run from Monday to Friday. Every week 22-30 class hours will be arranged. In addition, there will be special tutoring courses for HSK.

\* During the epidemic, online Chinese language classes will be provided. After the outbreak, the

registration fee will be waived for online students who continue to study offline.

Autumn semester: Online application ends June 30, 2026.

Spring semester: Online application ends January 1, 2026.

Chinese class (short-term): Short-term class (2-6 weeks); usually held in the winter and

summer holidays (starting from the third week of January or July each year). The specific class

time and teaching content can be arranged according to the requirements of the applicant. For

individual registration, a class should have at least 10 people. In case of group registration, the

learning time, teaching content and activity arrangement can be discussed.

\* Short-term advanced courses will include Chinese culture courses and special skills courses.

Chinese culture courses cover different areas such as Chinese culture, economic development,

history and geography, helping students get a comprehensive understanding of China.

Specialized skills courses can lay a solid foundation for students to adapt to undergraduate

courses in advance.

Completion and further education SSITY On

Upon completion: Students who pass the required courses and obtain the required credits will

be awarded the Certificate of Completion for Chinese Language Training issued by the Institute

of International Education.

Further education: Students who have completed all the teaching procedures prescribed in the

training program and passed the undergraduate qualification examination, they must take the

China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) and obtain the corresponding scores before

they can enter the undergraduate program of our school for study. Those who do not meet the

eligibility criteria for completion or fail to pass the qualification examination for admission to

the undergraduate program and do not take the China Scholastic Competency Assessment

(CSCA) are not allowed to enter the undergraduate study and can continue to study the

language program until they meet the requirements.

4. Fees structure:

Chinese Class (long term):

Chinese Language (1 semester): RMB 10500 Semester

Chinese Language (1 academic year): RMB 21000 Year

Chinese class (short-term):

The specific fee depends on the learning time, teaching content and activity arrangement.



#### Other expenses:

Application fee: RMB 400 or USD 70

Campus accommodation fee: 800 to 1200 RMB per month per person (Depending on the room

type)

## 6. Scholarship Application:

1) Category: Language Teachers (Confucius Institute) Scholarship (Can not apply without Chinese language foundation)

Admission category: one-academic year trainee and one-semester trainee.

a) Scholarship for Academic Year Study: The program commences in September 2026, and provides scholarship for a maximum of 11 months. International students who have benefited from similar scholarships are not eligible.

For the area of TCSOL, applicants shall have a minimum score of 270 on the HSK test (Level 3), and an HSKK test score is required.

For the areas of Chinese Language and Literature, applicants shall have a minimum score of 180 on the HSK test (Level 4) and 60 on the HSKK test (Intermediate Level).

For the area of Chinese Language Study, applicants shall have a minimum score of 210 on the HSK test (Level 3). Priority will be given to applicants who provide an HSKK test score.

b) **Scholarship for One-Semester Study:** The program commences either in September 2026 or March 2027, and provides scholarship of a maximum of five months. Applicants holding the X1 or X2 visa are not eligible.

For the areas of TCSOL, Chinese Language and Literature, applicants shall have a minimum score of 180 on the HSK test (Level 3), and an HSKK test score is required.



#### 2) Applicants Requirements:

- a) non-Chinese citizens;
- b) in good physical and mental conditions, and with good academic performance and conduct;
- c) committed to the Chinese language education and related work;
- d) between the ages of 16 and 35 (as of September 1st). Applicants currently working as Chinese language teachers shall not be over 45, while undergraduate student applicants shall not be over 25.

#### **Application Procedure**

- 1. Contact and choose a recommending institution. Usually, the Confucius Institute which you registered should be the recommending institution. Confucius Institutes, independently operated classrooms with the history for more than half a year (can be found at <a href="http://www.hanban.org">http://www.hanban.org</a>). Applicants may log on the application website of China University of Petroleum (Beijing) (<a href="https://cie-registration.cup.edu.cn/">https://cie-registration.cup.edu.cn/</a>) for registration, submit the application, and attend the interview. After passing the interview, they will receive a letter of recommendation.
- 2. Online Application: Applicants log in scholarship website <a href="http://cis.chinese.cn">http://cis.chinese.cn</a>, register then fill in the application on line.
- 3. Scholarship holders need to confirm with the host institutions to go through the procedures of studying in China, print out the scholarship certificate online, and register at host institutions on the designated date as per the letter of admission.

#### 3) Application Materials:

- 1. Scanned copies of all China visa pages and China entry and exit record pages
- 2. Scanned copies of score reports of the HSK and HSKK tests (within the two-year validity);
- 3. A reference letter by the head of the recommending institution
- 4. Online application form
- 5. Notarized copies of your Highest Degree certificates, and transcripts
- 6. Certificates of Chinese competitions you participated in institutions.
- 7. Applicants currently working as Chinese language teachers shall provide proof of employment as well as a reference letter by the employer.
- 8. Applicants under the age of 18 shall provide certified documents of designation signed by their entrusted legal guardians in China.

#### 4) Application Deadlines (Beijing Time):

- 1. Four-Week Students in July 2026: student application must complete before April 15th; recommending institutions and host institutions must complete review before April 25th;
- 2. One-Academic-Year / One semester students started in September 2026: student application must complete before May 15th; recommending institutions and host institutions must complete review before May 25th;
- 3. Four-Week Students in December 2026: student application must complete before September 15th; recommending institutions and host institutions must complete review before September 25th;
- 4. One semester students started in March 2027: student application must complete before October 31st; recommending institutions and host institutions must complete review before November 10th.
